Beefsteak/Extra Large	
Aichi First	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 0.5 lbs. Red Beefsteak fruit on 7' plants. Fruit have a pointed tip. Believed to be from Toyohashi, Aichi Prefecture, Japan Indeterminate.
Amana Orange	Early-Season Open Pollinated with 10 oz. Orange Beefsteak fruit on 5' plants. Sweet flavor at times somewhat bland. Indeterminate. From Amana, Iowa.
Aussie	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 1.5 lbs. Red Beefsteak fruit on 6' plants. A large beefsteak from Australia Indeterminate.
Bodacious	Late-Season Hybrid with 11 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 7' plants. Large fruit on semi compact vines Indeterminate.
Burpee's Supersteak	Late-Season Hybrid with 2 lbs. Red Beefsteak fruit on 3' plants. A large beefsteak bred by Burpee Indeterminate.
Dinner Plate	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 2 lbs. Red Beefsteak fruit on 8' plants. Large flattened fruit Indeterminate.
Dr. Lyle	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 1.5 lbs. Red Beefsteak fruit on 8' plants. An heirloom variety from George Korbel of West Virginia Indeterminate.
German Chocolate	Early-Season Open Pollinated with 16 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 6' plants. Rich chocolate color, sweet mild taste Indeterminate.
Giant Belgium	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 2 lbs. Pink Beefsteak fruit on 7' plants. Large, meaty fruit, sweet flavor? Indeterminate.
Hugh's	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 16 oz. Bi-color Beefsteak fruit on 7' plants. Indeterminate.
Kosovo	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 14 oz. Red Oxheart fruit on 7' plants. Came from a former U.N. worker in Kosovo, who passed it down to Carolyn Male. Indeterminate.
Marizol Gold	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 1.5 lbs. Bi-color Beefsteak fruit on 5' plants. Golden tomato with red blushing and red streaks through flesh. From the Black Forest region of Germany Indeterminate.
Mortgage Lifter	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 15 oz. Pink Beefsteak fruit on 7' plants. Mild flavor can be somewhat mealy. Indeterminate. Saved by M.C Byles in West Virginia who sold plants for \$1.00 in 1940 and paid off his \$6,000 mortgage in 6 years.
Super Beefsteak	Late-Season Hybrid with 17 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 8' plants. Smoother shoulders than other beefsteaks Indeterminate.

Badabing!	Early-Season Hybrid with 2 oz. Red Cherry fruit on 6' plants. 2026 All-American Selections winner. Semi compact plants Indeterminate.
Bing	Early-Season Open Pollinated with 1 oz. Red Cherry fruit on 6' plants. Produces in hot, dry climates, very sweet Indeterminate.

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Cherry Orange	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 1 oz. Orange Cherry fruit on 8' plants. Grows clusters of orange fruit Indeterminate.
Chocolate Cherry	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 0.5 oz. Black Cherry fruit on 7' plants. Indeterminate.
Chocolate Pear	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 1 oz. Red Small Pear fruit on 8' plants. Dark red fruit with green blush on shoulders. Indeterminate.
Early Bird	Mid-Season Hybrid with 2 oz. Red Cherry fruit on 8' plants. Cold-tolerant and can be directly sown outdoors after frost Indeterminate.
Gold Spark	Early-Season Hybrid with 2 oz. Yellow Grape fruit on 6' plants. High resistance to T and cracking, large, dark yellow beauties with unfailingly delicious?, sweet, meaty flesh Indeterminate.
Green Pear	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 1 oz. Green Small Pear fruit on 6' plants. Indeterminate.
Honeycomb	Mid-Season Hybrid with 0.5 oz. Orange Cherry fruit on 6' plants. Long clusters of fruit said to have a taste of honey. Indeterminate.
Indigo Dancing with Smurf	Late-Season Hybrid with 1 inch Red Cherry fruit on 8' plants. Red fruit with purple/black blush Indeterminate.
Moonbeam	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 0.5 oz. Yellow Small Pear fruit on 8' plants. Stunningly unique and packed with a tasty punch of unbeatable flavor? Indeterminate.
Park's Junior Whopper Pin	Mid-Season Hybrid with 0.5 oz. Pink Cherry fruit on 8' plants. Said to be good for snacking. Indeterminate VF.
Red Coral	Early-Season Hybrid with 1 oz. Red Grape fruit on 6' plants. An early commercial type grape. Determinate F.
Scarlet Sunrise	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 1.5 oz. Pink Grape fruit on 8' plants. Developed by Rutgers New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station (NJAES) tomato breeding team Indeterminate.
Starlight	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 0.5 oz. Yellow Grape fruit on 6' plants. Elongated, prolific and sweet Indeterminate.
Sugar Baby	Early-Season Open Pollinated with 2 oz. Red Cherry fruit on 2' plants. Early harvests of super-sweet tomatoes on compact plants. Determinate.
Sunrise Bumble Bee	Mid-Season Hybrid with 0.5 oz. Yellow Grape fruit on 6' plants. Yellow fruit with red stripes. Indeterminate.
White Cherry	Early-Season Hybrid with 1 oz. Yellow Cherry fruit on 6' plants. Pale yellow fruit, sweet and fruity Indeterminate.

Alicante	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 5 oz. Red Round fruit on 5' plants. Winner of the prestigious Royal Horticultural Society (RHS) Award of Garden Merit Indeterminate.
Arletta	Early-Season Hybrid with 6 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 7' plants. Slightly ribbed, cold tolerant Indeterminate.
Auriga	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 2.5 oz. Orange Round fruit on 5' plants. Sweet, juicy, high carotene content. Orange flesh streaked with red. Indeterminate.
BHN 589	Mid-Season Hybrid with 7 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 3' plants. A commercial farm variety with good flavor. Firm crack resistant fruit. Determinate.

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Big Beef Plus	Mid-Season Hybrid with 9 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 6' plants. Improved Big Beef with better flavor, color and disease resistance Indeterminate.
Black Beauty	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 8 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 8' plants. Very dark fruit with high levels of the antioxidant anthocyanin Indeterminate.
Black Prince	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 6 oz. Black Round fruit on 6' plants. Indeterminate.
Blonde Boar	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 5 oz. Yellow Round fruit on 8' plants. Yellow gold fruit with green stripes. A variety from the Wild Boar Series Indeterminate.
Bush Beefsteak	Early-Season Open Pollinated with 8 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 4' plants. Determinate.
Calypso	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 7 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 6' plants. Best suited for heat tolerant for hot/humid conditions Indeterminate.
Charlie Chaplin	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 7 oz. Red Stuffer fruit on 6' plants. Ruffled accordion shape, mostly hollow Indeterminate.
Chef's Choice Red	Late-Season Hybrid with 8 oz. Red Globe fruit on 5' plants. 2018 AAS winner. VFF. Indeterminate.
Chocolate Miracle	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 9 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 5' plants. Deep red fruit with dark shoulders Indeterminate.
Chocolate Stripes	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 16 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 5' plants. Beefsteak, complex sweet and earthy tomato flavor, dark red with green stripes Indeterminate.
Cream of the Crop Burton'	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 2 inches Red Round fruit on 5' plants. Orange and red striped, miniature oxheart Indeterminate.
Daytona	Mid-Season Hybrid with 4 oz. Red Round fruit on 3' plants. Plum shaped tomato. VFT. Determinate.
Green Pineapple	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 8 oz. Green Flattened Globe fruit on 5' plants. ropical Flavor with hint of pineapple. Indeterminate.
Indigo Blue Chocolate	Late-Season Hybrid with 1.5 oz. Pink Round fruit on 8' plants. Red fruit with purple shoulders. For shelf life, pick when fruits begin to show signs of turning color ripen indoors. Bred by Brad Gates at Wild Boar Farms Indeterminate.
KC 146	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 9 oz. Red Round fruit on 5' plants. Semi-Determinate F. Developed by Campbell's Soup Company as a processing tomato. Released in 1956 and used as a flavor standard.
Lancer	Mid-Season Hybrid with 10 oz. Red Round fruit on 5' plants. Commercial type with compact plants. Determinate VF.
Lemon Boy	Late-Season Hybrid with 6-7 oz. Yellow Round fruit on 5' plants. Mild Sweet yet tangy? A very popular yellow variety. Indeterminate VF1N.
Little Big Boy	Mid-Season Hybrid with 5 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 8' plants. Cold-tolerant and can be directly sown outdoors after frost Indeterminate.
Magic Bullet	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 0.5 oz. Bi-color Round fruit on 5' plants. Blue-black fruit with green stripes and red blush, complex flavor Indeterminate.
Moreton	Early-Season Hybrid with 8 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 5' plants. Indeterminate. An early season variety grown by Jersey farmers in 1960's. Seed was off the market and Rutgers worked with Harris Seeds and Eastern Seed Services to bring it back.

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Mountain Heritage	Mid-Season Hybrid with 10 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 5' plants. Red to purple skin. Fruits resist cracking and maintain quality after harvest. Indeterminate.
Mr. Stripey	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 14 oz. Yellow Round fruit on 6' plants. Tangy flavor? Indeterminate.
Myrtle	Late-Season Hybrid with 9 oz. Red Round fruit on 5' plants. Commercial type with compact plants. Determinate VFA.
Palpatation	Early-Season Hybrid with 9 oz. Red Stuffer fruit on 6' plants. Ruffled oxheart shape, mostly hollow Indeterminate.
Piccolo Carina	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 2 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 5' plants. Miniature tomatoes, 1.5 inches in diameter, scalloped and sweet Indeterminate.
Ramapo	Mid-Season Hybrid with 12 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 4' plants. Indeterminate. Developed by Dr. Bernie Pollack at Rutgers University, NJAES.
RuBee Plus	Mid-Season Hybrid with 9 oz. Red Round fruit on 6' plants. Firm fruit on semi compact plants. Indeterminate VFT.
Rugby	Early-Season Hybrid with 5 oz. Red Round fruit on 6' plants. Long pointed fruit with some resistance to early blight. Indeterminate VFT.
Rutgers	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 10 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 6' plants. Indeterminate. Originally developed at Rutgers U. for canning industry.
Rutgers 250	Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 10 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 4' plants. Semi-Determinate. Developed at Rutgers NJAES by redoing the cross used to create the original 'Rutgers' tomato ('JTD' X 'Marglobe'). Named to celebrate the 250th Anniversary of Rutgers University.
Spitze	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 5 oz. Red Pear fruit on 4' plants. From Romania Indeterminate.
Tastemaster Improved	Mid-Season Hybrid with 7 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 5' plants. Deep pink fruit Determinate.
Trophy	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 5-7 oz. Red Round fruit on 6' plants. Indeterminate. Introduced in 1870 by Colonel George Waring of Newport, RI.
Tutti-Frutti Paprika	Mid-Season Hybrid with 1.4 oz. Red Round fruit on 8' plants. Elongated firm fruit Indeterminate.
Wapsipinicon Peach	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 4 oz. Yellow Round fruit on 7' plants. Fuzzy fruit. Indeterminate. Originated with Elbert S. Carman in 1890 under the name White Peach. This strain came from Dennis Schlicht and is named after the Wapsipinicon River in northeast Iowa.
White Snowball	Late-Season Open Pollinated with 7 oz. White Round fruit on 8' plants. Unique creamy white color. Said to be low a low acid variety. Indeterminate.
