| Burgundy Traveler     | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 12 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 5' plants. Similar to Brandywine, heat tolerant Indeterminate.   |
| Chocolate Stripes     | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 16 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 5' plants. Beefsteak, complex sweet and earthy tomato flavor, dark red with green stripes Indeterminate. |
| Garden Leader Monster | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 20 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 6' plants. Very large tomato, VF Indeterminate.  |
| German Chocolate      | Early-Season Open Pollinated with 16 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 6' plants. Rich chocolate color, sweet mild taste Indeterminate.                                       |
| Grandpap's Rose Wax   | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 12 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 6' plants. From Roughwood Seed Collection, sweet and slightly tart Indeterminate.                        |
| Livingston's Paragon  | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 8 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 7' plants. Developed in 1870 by Alexander Livingston Indeterminate.                                       |
| Mandarin Cross        | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 10 oz. Yellow Beefsteak fruit on 5' plants. Firm flesh, sweet and low acid Indeterminate.  |
| Mikado                | Late-Season Open Pollinated with 24 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 7' plants. Introduced in 1886 in Iowa, first known potato leaf variety Indeterminate.                   |
| Orange Brandywine     | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 16 oz. Orange Beefsteak fruit on 5' plants. Pure orange beefsteak Indeterminate.   |
| Pink Jazz             | Late-Season Hybrid with 16 oz. Red Beefsteak fruit on 7' plants. Pink fruit with yellow stripes Indeterminate.   |

| Gold Spark        | Early-Season Hybrid with 2 oz. Yellow Grape fruit on 6' plants. High resistance to T and cracking, large, dark yellow beauties with unfailingly delicious?, sweet, meaty flesh Indeterminate. |

| Starlight         | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 0.5 oz. Yellow Grape fruit on 6' plants. Elongated, prolific and sweet Indeterminate.  |
| Sun Dipper        | Early-Season Hybrid with 1 oz. Orange Grape fruit on 7' plants. Unusual elongated hourglass shape Indeterminate.   |
| Sweetie           | Early-Season Open Pollinated with 1 oz. Red Cherry fruit on 6' plants. Said to have high sugar content. Indeterminate.   |
| White Cherry      | Early-Season Hybrid with 1 oz. Yellow Cherry fruit on 6' plants. Pale yellow fruit, sweet and fruity Indeterminate.  |
| Wooly Kate Yellow | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 0.5 oz. Yellow Cherry fruit on 5' plants. Unusual yellow fruit with blue shoulders and peach fuzz Indeterminate.                                   |

| Destiny               | Mid-Season Hybrid with 9 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 5' plants. Hardy with good leaf cover, resists Yellow Leaf Curl Determinate.                      |

| Hy Beef 9904          | Mid-Season Hybrid with 9 oz. Red Round fruit on 4' plants. Semi-seedless with dense interior, VF Determinate.   |
| Independence Day      | Early-Season Open Pollinated with 2 oz. Red Round fruit on 6' plants. Produces tomatoes by July 4 Indeterminate.  |
| Jolene                | Early-Season Hybrid with 10 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 4' plants. Beefsteak, sets fruit in heat, VF Determinate.                                      |

| Ramapo                | Mid-Season Hybrid with 12 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 4' plants. Indeterminate. Developed by Dr. Bernie Pollack at Rutgers University, NJAES.  |
| Red Bounty            | Mid-Season Hybrid with 12 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 3' plants. Hybrid bush tomato, extra large fruit, VF. Determinate.   |
| Red Torch             | Early-Season Hybrid with 1.5 oz. Red Round fruit on 6' plants. Red with yellow stripes, crack resistant, AAS winner. Indeterminate.   |
| RuBee Goddess         | Early-Season Hybrid with 7 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 6' plants. Large fruit, strong vigor, VF. Indeterminate.  |
| Rutgers 250           | Mid-Season Open Pollinated with 10 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 4' plants. Semi-Determinate. Developed at Rutgers NJAES by redoing the cross used to create the original 'Rutgers' tomato ('JTD' X 'Marglobe'). Named to celebrate the 250th Anniversary of Rutgers University. |
| Sheryl                | Mid-Season Hybrid with 7 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 4' plants. Firm, meaty, sweet fruit, VF. Determinate.   |
| Strawberry Fields     | Mid-Season Hybrid with 10 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 6' plants. Good late blight resistance. Indeterminate.   |
| Tastemaster Improved  | Mid-Season Hybrid with 7 oz. Red Flattened Globe fruit on 5' plants. Deep pink fruit. Determinate.  |
| Traveler 76           | Late-Season Open Pollinated with 6 oz. Red Round fruit on 5' plants. Heat and drought resistant, crack resistant. Indeterminate.  |
